# **BOOK CONTENT GUIDELINES**

Deadline for Book Submissions May 14, 2024

## **ABOUT THIS LIST**

A dozen social studies educators comprise the book selection committee, guided by three main reviewers. The list is promoted at the NCSS Annual Conference and in the NCSS journal *Social Education* and *Social Studies and the Young Learner*.

The CBC will promote the award winners list to our opt-in email list of teachers, librarians, and booksellers. The final 2024 PDF was downloaded over 8,000 times.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

- Books must be published in the calendar year 2024.
- Books must be intended for grades K-12.
- Both fiction and nonfiction are eligible.
- Original paperbacks are eligible; paperback reprints are not. If a book is published simultaneously in hardcover and paperback, either edition may be submitted. If both editions are submitted, they constitute separate entries.
- Revised editions of books originally published in the U.S. before 2024 are eligible only if the book
  has been newly illustrated or if substantial text at least 25% of the book has been changed or
  added.
- Textbooks and workbooks are not eligible.
- Books originally published abroad are eligible only if they have a 2024 U.S. publication date; reprints or licensed editions of books initially published in the U.S. before December 2023 are not eligible.
- Spanish-language editions published in the U.S. simultaneously with English-language editions in 2024 are eligible.
- Books published October- December 2023 may be eligible. (Email Paulina at paulina.ramirez@cbcbooks.org for details).

# SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The selection panel looks for books that:

- Emphasize human relationships
- Objectively reflect real world situations

- Represent a diversity of readership and avoid stereotypes
- Are sensitive to a broad range of cultural experiences
- Present an original theme or a fresh approach to a traditional topic (address a current void in children's literature)
- Are of high literary quality
- Where appropriate, include illustrations that enrich the text
- Include citations, a bibliography, or resource list where appropriate.

- The spreadsheet contains two different tabs: one tab for publisher info and another tab for your title submissions

- We will email you shipping instructions in July.
- You will be asked to send each title to three reviewers (3 copies in total)
